So that's when we found MSC, and where my love for motocross really grew, and I found friendships that will last me a lifetime.

Haha funny story. My first race was the LOVELY hurricane hills. Not so lovely actually for a 5 year old... I had just gotten off my training wheels and I begged my dad to let me ride. He had warned me about the gigantic hill that I would have to go over but I brushed it off. Here I was, lined

up at the gate with a bunch of cobras, 65s and mini ktm's. Then there was me on a little CRF 50. I got stuck on the big hill, but that's okay, I didn't finish last. I do remember how much of a blast I had. I remember singing Hannah Montana's theme song to myself to keep me calm... LOL

#### Favorite Track?

I love them all, but by far, I would have to say Unadilla. The first time I raced Dilla, I was around 11. I just loved the thrill of going down gravity cavity and it always feels like an honor whenever I get to ride the track. I go up there to watch the nationals and it's just an amazing thing to be able to say, "I raced the same track as Justin Barcia."

#### 2018 Goals

My goals for 2018 are simple, to maintain my placement. For me, I tend to have okay starts and then slowly move back in placement. My goal for this season is to give it my 100% the

ENTIRE race, not just half of it.

#### Favorite Bike Brand and why?

Honda. I know, most people aren't a fan, and I own a Kawi myself but if I would have to rank the BEST bike out there I'd say a Honda. Why? I have owned one Honda and I have ridden many. Every Honda I have ridden has handled great. I have heard from many friends that the reason that they keep going back to Honda is because of how well the bikes are put together. That parts always fit perfectly and they're usually no struggle to get installed. While the bikes aren't as fast as the Kawi's, the handling and maintenance

aspect may outweigh the speed.

#### Worst Crash?

My worst crash had to be at Southwick 3 years ago. I still have no skin on my left leg and there's a huge patch of skin where I just have no nerve feeling at all. At the time, I was on a KX65. The sand didn't settle with me well. I never liked the feeling of

it, but I was determined to try it again. I went around a turn full throttle and I fell. But when I fell, my boot got stuck and the exhaust pipe fell right on my leg. I got slammed to the ground and I was stuck. The worst part?



No flagger around to help me. Now, this bike for me was heavy. I was a 14-year-old girl but, I was small for my age. As I bent up, my leg wouldn't move from the exhaust pipe and my I saw the pipe burning a hole in my pants. I was screaming, trying to



squirm my way out but, I couldn't. I saw my own skin burn off before my eyes and when I finally broke free, I got up, and felt a huge chunk of skin fell to the bottom of my boot. I rode off the track crying and wound up with a strong degree burn. I had skin graphing just to get my

skin looking remotely normal. I consider myself lucky in that I haven't had to been rushed to hospital.

#### Any advice for kids just starting out?

It'll be hard at first, the learning how to balance, and when to put your foot out is difficult, but I can promise you, there will come a time where it will all become muscle memory. Another thing, you will fall, but don't be scared, all riders fall, even Ryan Dungey does, and if you get hurt, just remember one thing, you are doing something that most people in the world are too scared to do. Be passionate and happy with who you are. Most kids aren't fortunate and/or brave enough to do what you do! Racing Career Highlights?

I will always remember the day that I won my first race and how happy I was. It was at Broome Tioga. That was also the day I got my first hole shot.
